## 1. Confirmation on Offer Acceptance

All successful candidates MUST confirm their offer acceptance through CMU-IPAS during **May 23<sup>rd</sup> -29<sup>th</sup>, 2019** at <http://www1.reg.cmu.ac.th/reg-ipas/main/index.php?action=apply> using the same email address and password given during application process.

### **For Thai candidate:**

For Thai candidates, CMU-IPAS adopts the same code of conduct on “Offer Reply” for TCAS lead by the Council of University Presidents of Thailand (CUPT). Here are procedures regarding the code conduct:

- 1) A successful Thai candidate must reply to the offer in BOTH systems, **CMU-IPAS during May 23<sup>rd</sup> -29<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and TCAS during June 17<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019**. If a candidate fails to do so, this will be considered as the “Decline ALL offers”.
- 2) A candidate can accept **ONLY ONE** faculty/field of study out of the list of Offers.
- 3) A candidate has only 3 counts to be able to change the acceptance on preferred faculty/field of study upon available offers. The counting starts at the first time the candidate making the acceptance. Each candidate can turn down an allocated spot just once but the change must be made within the designated time frame, this counts as the second. The third time will be the last and it cannot be changed anymore except to “Decline ALL offers”.
- 4) Once a confirmed acceptance has been made, the candidate is not eligible to apply to the next available intake(s). If needed, he/she must decline – on the other hand – revoke his/her acceptance in order to be eligible to apply to the upcoming round of admission.

### **For Non-Thai candidate**

During the accepting offer confirmation, Non-Thai candidate needs to upload documents including CMR01-04 and the letter of permission to participate on field trip and practicum with the signatures of candidate and parent/guardian. These documents can be downloaded from CMU IPAS admission system. The same set of original documents of CMR02-04 and the letter of permission to participate on field trip and practicum must be handed in during the new student registration dates together with the updated CMR01.

**Suggested date of arrival to Chiang Mai University: Before July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

## 2. VISA Process for Non-Thai Candidate:

All Non-Thai candidates who accepted the offer must apply for a “NON-IMMIGRANT VISA-ED” (or NON-ED” Visa) **BEFORE** leaving their home country to study at Chiang Mai University.

Steps to obtain the VISA is as follows:

- 1) Log in our CMU-IPAS to provide the information regarding your passport (valid for no less than 6 months) that you will carry during your study in Thailand and information on location of a Thai Embassy/Consulate at which you wish to apply for the VISA. (see detail on locations of a Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate for each country at <http://www.thaiembassy.org/main/> )

- 2) The information will be forwarded to Chiang Mai University's International Relations Division (CMU-IRD). CMU-IRD will prepare and email an Official Acceptance Letter and VISA documents that you will need to apply for the VISA.
- 3) Contact and apply for the VISA at the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate as specified in the document to apply for the VISA. Depending on each location, additional required documents and fees will be collected, and, more so, it could take 3 weeks or more for the VISA be granted. Collect your VISA from the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate after a notification. - 4) The VISA is only valid for 90 days after the date of arrival. After entering Thailand, VISA holders must contact the Immigration Bureau of Thailand for the extension of stay for another year for every year, and re-entry permit.

**Important: All international students at Chiang Mai University MUST enter Thailand with NON-ED VISA. Do not enter with a tourist VISA.**

### 3. New Student Registration

All confirmed candidates must complete the new student registration forms including CMR01-04 and the letter of permission to participate on field trip and practicum by following these steps:

1. **During June 18<sup>th</sup> -26<sup>th</sup>, 2019**, sign-in at [www3.reg.cmu.ac.th/stdinfo/undergraduate/](http://www3.reg.cmu.ac.th/stdinfo/undergraduate/) using Citizen ID/ Passport number and password given during application process.
  - **For Thai candidate**, fill in or update personal data on CMR01-04 and the letter of permission to participate on field trip and practicum.
  - **For Non-Thai candidate**, CMR01-04 and the letter of permission to participate on field trip and practicum have already been filled and uploaded during accepting offer confirmation. However, please update personal data, eg. VISA and address in Thailand, on CMR01.
2. **During July 17<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019**, print out the documents and attach a photo onto each copy of CMR01 form. Have the documents signed by parents/guardian.
3. Together with the 2 sets of signed documents of CMR01-04 and the letter of permission to participate on field trip and practicum, the following relevant documents are required:
  - 1) Original Certificate verifying completion of High School or Grade 12 or Mathayom Suksa 6 or the equivalent with two photo copies.
  - 2) Original high school official transcripts with two photo copies, in Thai or English.
  - 3) For international candidate: Five copies of passport on passport holder's information page, visa page, arrival stamped page and departure card.
  - 4) Three one-inch (3 cm. x 4 cm.) full-face photographs, wearing CMU's student uniform, taken within the last 3 months.
  - 5) A certified copy of the scholarship document (if applicable).

4. **During July 23<sup>rd</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019**, proceed to Chiang Mai University's Registration Building, RB5, to report and hand in all documents listed above. Specific times for each study program will be announced at [www.reg.cmu.ac.th](http://www.reg.cmu.ac.th). All new students must wear CMU's student uniform on this day. Candidates who fail to report during the new student registration dates will be automatically disqualified.

#### 4. Health Checkup Procedures

All confirmed candidates are required to have a medical checkup including chest X-ray at Chiang Mai University's main gymnasium on **July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019**. Health checkup's fee of 630 Thai baht will be collected for all students except those who are accepted to NSC program, the fee will be 1,920 Thai baht. Please print out the health checkup form on both sides of a single paper from <https://www1.reg.cmu.ac.th/ugradapply/> Fill in and attach 1 photo before proceed to get the health checkup as per the schedule below:
